# DRESS CODE

## STANDARD OF DRESS

Our dress code helps maintain the traditions of the game while ensuring all members and guests feel comfortable and respected. We ask that you please observe the following guidelines both on the course and in the clubhouse.

## ON THE GOLF COURSE

### ACCEPTABLE ATTIRE

**MEN:** Collared or mock-neck golf shirts, tailored trousers or shorts (Bermuda length), golf-specific outerwear.

**WOMEN:** Collared shirts, sleeveless golf shirts with collars, tailored trousers, golf skirts, skorts, or Bermuda-length shorts, golf-specific outerwear.

Golf shoes with soft spikes - Metal spikes not permitted.

### UNACCEPTABLE ATTIRE

- Denim jeans, cut-offs, cargo shorts, or sports shorts (e.g., gym or basketball shorts).
- T-shirts, tank tops, halter tops, or sports jerseys.
- Flip-flops, sandals, or metal-spiked shoes.

### IN THE CLUBHOUSE

#### ACCEPTABLE ATTIRE

- Smart casual dress at all times.
- Golf attire is welcome before and after play.
- Tailored denim in good condition (no rips or fraying) is acceptable.

#### UNACCEPTABLE ATTIRE

- Hats or visors worn backwards.
- Sleeveless shirts for men.
- Swimwear, gym wear, or soiled clothing.

#### ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES

- Shirts must be tucked in unless designed to be worn untucked.
- Please remove caps and visors in the main dining room.
- Junior golfers are expected to adhere to the same standards.
